Glass Fusing and Slumping – all levels

On the first day you will gain an overview of the many techniques possible for working with glass in the kiln by completing three small projects. On the second day you have the opportunity to put these skills into practice with some major projects of your choice. Materials are supplied on day one but you will need to purchase materials for your major projects.

Glass Fusing and Slumping – one day wonders

Leadlight weekend

In one weekend you will learn the major aspects of this ancient craft as you cut and build your own small window. All aspects will be covered including health and safety, glass cutting, leading, soldering, finishing and polishing. Most tools supplied except a glass cutter. You will need to purchase your glass and lead.

Decals –drawings and photos on glass

Have you wanted to transfer a particular photo or image onto fused glass? You will learn how to make decals (Image transfers) using a printer on special paper. Students will need to bring an image or multiple images (up to one page at US letter size) on a USB stick. A basic understanding of computer photo manipulation required.
