## Glass Fusing and Slumping (beginners plus previous students) - \$ 155

During this one day course you will complete three small projects – a slumped glass platter, a tile or small coloured bowl or plate, and some jewellery.. Basic materials are supplied but some students choose to purchase some extra coloured glass and make extra projects.

## Story blocks and decals - a fusing extension class \$195

In this class we will make one cast block using sepia images of your choice that will be transferred to the glass with simple decal transfers that can be printed from your own photographs. The image block will use 4-5 images in multiple layers to build up a story. We will also cover how to make and apply decals for jewellery, plates and other fused projects.
