Leadlight weekend - \$250

Over two days (one weekend) you will learn the major aspects of this ancient craft as you cut and build your own small window. At the conclusion, you will have enough skills to continue at home if you choose. Most tools are supplied except a glass cutter. You will need to purchase your glass and lead, and this can be arranged at the class.

For beginners and experienced students

Introduction to Tiffany (copper foil technique) - \$155

You will have the choice to make a hinged box or an open container or suncatchers to hang in your window. You will learn glass cutting, foiling and soldering and you will walk away with a beautiful creation for your home or as a gift. At the conclusion, you will have enough skills to continue at home if you choose. (Tiffany lamp shades can be made during the lamp class)

Sat 18th September, 9.30 am – 4.30 pm

Glass Fusing and Slumping (beginners plus previous students) - \$ 160

During this one-day course you will complete three small projects – a slumped glass platter, a tile or small coloured bowl or plate, and some jewellery. Basic materials are supplied but some students choose to purchase some additional coloured glass and make extra projects.

Lampshade weekend - \$235 INCLUDING pop up leadlight class

Choose from one of four simple patterns supplied to make your beautiful copper foil light shade in the glass of your choice. Everything is supplied for the shade except the glass which should cost between \$65-90 and a glass cutter (both are available at the studio). At the conclusion, you will have enough skills to continue at home if you choose. OR you may choose to learn how to make a leadlight window – details as for the leadlight class.

Family fun – mosaic pot with succulent - \$170 (adult and child)
