Glass Fusing and Slumping (beginners plus previous students) - \$ 145

During this one day course, you will complete three small projects – a slumped glass platter, a dinner plate and some jewellery. Merinda will take you through the technical considerations as well design ideas. Basic materials are supplied but some students choose to purchase some extra coloured glass. If you have done previous classes you are welcome to join in and I can help you extend your skills.

Saturday 26th August 10am – 3.30pm

Glass Fusing – Christmas is coming! - \$ 130

Do you want a chance to make some unique handmade Christmas presents for your friends or families? Or you may like to make some decorations. This one day session with a Christmas focus may be for you. The course fee covers tuition, small glass off cuts and kiln firings. You will purchase larger pieces of glass for your projects and the cost will vary depending on what you choose. (estimate an extra \$25 +)

Saturday 11th November 10.30am – 3.30pm

Leadlight weekend - \$220

In one weekend you will learn the major aspects of this ancient craft as you cut and build your own small window. All aspects will be covered including health and safety, glass cutting, leading, soldering, finishing and polishing. Most tools supplied except a glass cutter (can purchase on the day). You will need to purchase your glass and lead and this can be arranged at the class.

Sat 15th October & Sun. 16th October 9.30am – 4.30pm each day

Copper foil projects - \$115

In this one day work shop you will learn the skills to make projects in copper foil. Usually copper foil is suited to more delicate projects such as jewellery boxes, sun catchers and simple lamp shades. Course fee covers tuition, use of tools (except a glass cutter, which you can purchase on the day) and chemicals. You will need to purchase your glass and solder and this can be arranged at the class.

Saturday 16th September 9.30am – 4.30pm

Private and special interest classes

Are you part of a social or special interest group? Do you want to have a fun and creative experience with friends? Get a group together and I'll be happy to design a short session in the studio. For example, a calligraphy group learnt different ways to put words into glass; a group of home schooled children made coasters and jewellery to learn about design and glass craft work.

A deposit of 25% of the class fee is required to secure your place. This is non-refundable within 6 weeks of the class except where the class is cancelled by us. There needs to be a minimum enrolment of 4 people for each course to be viable unless otherwise noted (maximum group size is 8).
