Glass Fusing and Slumping (beginners plus previous students) - \$ 155

This is a comprehensive introduction to creating glass art in a kiln. During the one day class you will complete three projects – a slumped glass platter, a large coloured tile and some jewellery. Merinda will take you through the technical considerations as well design ideas. Basic materials are supplied but some students choose to purchase some extra coloured glass. Often there is extra time for you to make some other pieces of your choosing. If you have done previous classes you are welcome to join in and I can help you extend your skills or you can work on a specific project of your choice. Minimum 5 students

Leadlight weekend - \$240

Over two days (one weekend) you will learn the major aspects of this ancient craft as you cut and build your own small window. At the conclusion, you will have enough skills to continue at home if you choose. All aspects will be covered including health and safety, glass cutting, leading, soldering, finishing and polishing. Most tools are supplied except a glass cutter. You will need to purchase your glass and lead and this can be arranged at the class.

Lost Wax Casting - \$190

Join with Ruth Downham and Merinda to learn about casting glass into 3D objects using the lost wax method. All materials will be supplied. On the first day you will carve your object in wax and then cast it into a mould so ready for firing in the kiln. The following week you will return for the grand unveiling and clean-up. This course is suited for people of all levels and with two teachers, you will get twice the information and experience to guide you.

Painting on glass - \$160

Glass painting adds dimension to your work with specialised paints that are fired on to the glass for a permanent non fading application. The processes you will learn can be used in stained glass or in fused works. In the first session you will learn a number of techniques and have a chance to make some samples. In the second session we will review the samples and have a chance to make some platters putting your new skills into action. An interest in painting or drawing would be helpful but not essential. Materials supplied. Minimum 5 students
